Global Climate Action Postcard Campaign to beat the Guinness World Record of the largest composed postcard

As you are aware, the Paris Agreement concluded in 2015 intends to stop global warming at a maximum of +2°C compared to pre-industrial times. In such an endeavor children and young people are key players – both, as the generations that will have to live longer with tomorrow's climate as well as driving force to achieve a climate compatible development. With this view, Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) through its Global Programme Climate Change and Environment (GPCCE) is mobilizing young children from all over the world to participate in a global postcard campaign.

The objective of the initiative is to spread the message “We are the future Give us a chance” written on the largest postcard composed of 100000 small post cards among world community. The largest ever composed postcard is going to be exposed on the Aletsch glacier in Switzerland – the longest and deepest glacier of the Alps. Centre for Environment Education (CEE) in India is facilitating this campaign with SDC to get 20,000 postcards from schools from different parts of the country.

‘Do you and your school want to take action for a safer climate and become part of a new Guinness World Record at the same time? How? Easy – paint a postcard on which you tell the world about your climate action!’

We are pleased to invite schools to be part of this campaign of climate action and become part of a new Guinness World Record. Young students from 6 to 20 years of age need to


paint his / her postcard. Students must write and/or visualize his/her commitment to improve the world's climate and limit global warming to a maximum of +2°C.

By sending us the postcards every young learner agrees to have his/her art piece exposed for the Guinness World Record and further used for non-commercial / not for profit communication purposes including subsequent events. The deadline for delivering the postcards to CEE is **5 September 2018 at the latest**.

We look forward to your participation in the campaign for sustainable future.

Guidelines for post card:

- Use **DIN A6** i.e. **148 mm x 105 mm** cards
- Use solid paper of **140-250 g/m²**
- **The student has to:**
- Write and visualize his/her **commitment** to improve the world's climate and limit global warming to a maximum of +2°C
- Add his/her **name and surname**
- Add the **name of the school, the location** (city, village) and the **country**
- **All components must appear on one side of the postcard only**
