**Theme-** Greening and Biodiversity

**Objective-** To do the overall development of the village adopted.

**Need of the project-** Generally the projects or schemes that are run or are being implemented in rural areas focus only on one aspect and that is economic development and progress. However overall development of a village will encompass many more aspects such as its cultural aspects, social issues, education and health, hygiene and sanitation etc. and there should be proper co-ordination, cooperation and collaboration of all the stakeholders in implementing schemes and programmes to achieve the goal of overall development of a village.

**How you will achieve it-** The first thing will be to identify and select a village which is not very small or large but having a population of near-about 1000 villagers. Then to make a group of 10-15 people who are willing to take initiatives and to bring about change.

Based on this survey the villages will be categorised into 3 groups namely Kiran gram - where development is in the initial phase, Uday Gram- where some additional efforts will lead to overall development of the village and Prabhat Gram- such villages which are moving towards overall development.

Based on the findings, will take-up one Kiran village and start implementing my project by taking simple initiatives.
